Attendances at PV has gone up ~20% since November.

Two Easter events well attended.

CHI are getting a sign to make it clearer where they are in PV.

Social History project - interviewed about 15 people so far, have approx. 7 hours of footage. Hope to do 10 more before starting the editing.

Met up with HBC Lifelong Learning team – agreed CHI can start delivering 5-week courses; creative writing, sewing for beginners, upcycling, radio drama, cooking of a budget and basic IT. CHI working out a timetable for it.

Loan Shark training – very interesting but shocking. England's Money Lending Team believe there are Loan Sharks on the estate – everyone to look for the signs. Put something in the newsletter. Is also a grant funding that CHI could apply for?

PS said he is aware of an email sent to the Partnership about CHI and if anyone wants to discuss it further they can talk to him, ST or TL at another time.

CH asked who target audience is? Sessions for 18+ and run during School hours so parents with children in school can make it. JTynan has 5 people already interested in participating with 3 others in the portraiture element on the course.

JThain thinks more money is needed for ink! JTynan to make a modest charge for all prints which will pay for more ink cartridges. An option for emailing photos for free. Hope to get involved in designing logos and leaflets etc – good feedback so far! Pixel Perfect will also attend and document events for Big Local to help with BL publicity. Hope to grow into covering photographing parties, weddings etc. where they could charge, and help make Pixel Perfect sustainable. Pixel Perfect are separately constituted from CHI, but TL is involved with both. CF asked about Public Liability Insurance. In Priory View they are covered by CHI but will need it for any activity outside Priory View. JTynan to investigate getting PLI.

CHI (PT, ST, TL,) and JT A-MT all left the room.

Partnership impressed and think they deserve the opportunity to give Pixel Perfect a go! Grant approved.

MS concerned although the sessions will be delivered on the estate the applicant herself is not a BL resident. CHI feel there is a demand for it from those attending PV and helped with the application as they are keen to promote women's exercise and health. Worries about the sustainability after the 10 weeks – would need to charge £4 each to cover costs. MS - Could Wellbeing Enterprises fund it? Ideally BL need to find a resident that can deliver similar activities on the estate.

Big Local Plan Review: Anne Sherriff

Before next year's Big Local plan can be agreed and submitted to Local Trust a review must be done of the existing plan. Local Trust requires every Partnership to answer 9 questions as part of their plan review.

- 1: What has your Big Local area done against what was in your Plan?
- 2: What money have you spent?
- 3: What Impact have you had?
- 4: What have you learned?
- 5 & 6: Have you progressed your Vision and Priorities? Do you need to refresh your vision and priorities?
- 7: How does this relate to the Big Local Outcomes?
- 8: Do you need a new or revised Plan or will you continue with the existing Plan?
- 9: How do you know this is what your community wants?

For Q1, AS asked the Partnership to judge progress made against each theme in the plan on a scale of 1 to 9. AS will then work out an average.
Q2 – DE to provide expenditure figures.
Q3 – AS split Partnership into three groups and did a carousel exercise where each group considered, in turn, the three key themes in the current Plan and
